### Key Performance Indicators (KPIs)

#### Admissions to the profession (2021 exam cohort)

The KPI figures below record the length of time taken by the Faculty Office to respond to an application for admission to the profession during the year to 31 March 2022 (2021 figures in brackets by way of comparison).

32 admission applications were received of which 30 have been determined. Of those, 21 notaries have returned their admission documents and applied for their first practising certificate. It should be noted that the length of time taken to complete an application is dependent on a number of factors which are outside of Faculty Office control including receiving a professional reference and sworn declaration from the applicant and the time taken by the external calligraphers to engross and return the Faculty.

The blacked-out boxes indicate data for which meaningful KPIs cannot be set as much of the timeline is outside of the control of the Faculty Office but it is included as it does give an indication of the timescale to complete the process from receipt of an application for admission to commencement of practice as a notary.
